Neonatal Resuscitation Program

The Neonatal Resuscitation Program is based on the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) and American Heart Association (AHA) Guidelines for Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation and Emergency Cardiovascular Care of the Neonate. The NRP course format requires learners to study the material from the *Textbook of Neonatal Resuscitation, 6th Edition*, and take an online examination before attending the NRP course. Learners attend an interactive course that includes little or no lecture about textbook contents, uses course time for skills stations and supervised practice, and uses simulation and debriefing as an important part of the learning experience. Candidates must be health-care providers (medical, nursing, paramedical allied health professionals) whose daily occupations demand proficiency in neonatal delivery room resuscitation.

Online examination

Upon registration, detailed directions to access the NRP online examination will be sent to course participants. The online examination will be assigned to students by the Training Center.

The NRP online examination must be taken no more than 30 days prior to skill session. If the online exam is completed more than 30 days before skill session, the examination is invalid and course participant must pay to take it again. **Once the online testing is started, it must be completed within 14 days.**

Prerequisites and preparation

The following must be completed to prepare for the course:

- ❖ Review lessons 1-9 in your textbook.
- ❖ Review and understand the information on the student DVD.
- ❖ Complete the lesson review questions for lessons 1-9 and turn in pre-study packet day of course
- ❖ **Take and pass** the online examination no more than 30 days prior to course.

Bring the certificate of completion the day of skill testing.
